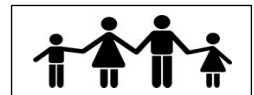


Tuesday, February 28th- Slumber Party Under the Stars! - Wear pajamas (CCSD dress code enforced), and bring a small blanket & flashlight.
